Landing Page

Book Club Kits are designed to help you hold your own book discussions. Each kit comes in a canvas bag, and contains 10 copies of the title as well as discussion questions and a sign out sheet.

GUIDELINES

- Book Club Kits are signed out for 35 days at a time.
- No renewals.
- All copies of the books must be returned with the kit to be checked in.
- Please allow a minimum of 10 days processing when requesting an available book club kit.





1. To fill out a Booking Request, please include your Name, Email, where you'd like to pick up your item, Library Card and any notes that might be important for us to know (or your Book Club name). Phone numbers are optional, but preferred.
2. Once you have filled out the requested fields, check off "I Agree" to the policy.
3. Scroll down to the bottom of the page and select Reserve Item. You will receive a confirmation email with the pick up and due date. A reminder email is sent 24 hour in advance of your item being ready for pick up.
