For over 20 years, ABC Life Literacy Canada has united Libraries, schools, and literacy organizations on Family Literacy Day to raise awareness about the importance of literacy skills. Family literacy activities strengthen the relationship between family members which, in turn, encourages lifelong learning."

This year, the Stratford Public Library is partnering with the Stratford Perth Museum to offer a special afterschool program for families. Join in the fun at the Museum for Dear Families, a program that encourages families to try out typewriters, printmaking, stamping and more.
