LIBRARY SERVICES IN PROVINCIAL SHUTDOWN

With the Province returning to shutdown, Stratford Public Library will modify services once more to comply, effective Saturday, April 3, 2021.

Given the short notice, Saturday, April 3rd service will consist of curbside pick-up only. Customers are encouraged to place items on hold through our catalogue and pick them up when they become available.

Tuesday, April 6th, the Library will welcome the community back to the restricted suite of in-person services, including curbside pick-up, and appointment-only Wi-Fi, computer, and printer/copier use. The book drop remains open, all hours, for returns.

The hours of service will remain the same: Monday to Thursday 10am-8pm, Fridays & Saturdays 10am-4pm. The Library is closed Good Friday, and Easter Monday.

Staff are pleased to continue exciting online programs for all ages including online activities throughout Spring break. The MakerSpace will be offering virtual open labs for vinyl cutting and 3D printing lessons.
