For every dollar invested in your library, Stratford residents receive \$7.48 in value


The return on investment to the City of Stratford and its citizens is **648.2%**

\$14.91 million annually in total economic impact on the City of Stratford




2015 By the Numbers



2015 Highlights

- The **Children's Floor** was revitalized with reorganized spaces, updated furniture and a fresh new look.
- All children's **storytimes are now drop-in**. SPL storytimes now follows the American Library Association's Every Child Ready to Read curriculum, focusing on school readiness.
- **10 new parking spaces** on St. Andrew Street were added.
- The Summer Reading Club hosted many events in the community, partnering with the Stratford Municipal Airport, the Stratford Fire Department, the Local Community Food Centre, and Festival Marketplace.
- The 11-year old **Public Library On Wheels** van was replaced through community fundraising.
- SPL partnered with the Avon Maitland District School Board to offer **all students** a card and orientation to Library resources.
- SPL was nominated for the Minister's Award for Innovation for its collaborative "Code-A-Character" program with the University of Waterloo. (Ministry of Tourism, Culture & Sport)
- **Chromebook** computers were added to increase the number of public computers available for use in the Library.
