
2016 Highlights

- Over 500 people walked through our doors every day! This is a 20% increase when compared to 2014.
- Created a Quiet Study Room to meet the needs of those who prefer to use the library with less noise.
- The **Children's Floor Program Room was refurbished** thanks to a generous donation by the International Order of the Daughters of the Empire.
- Building on the success of 2015, the Summer Reading Club partnered again with community organizations including the Stratford Municipal Airport, the Stratford Fire Department, the Local Community Food Centre, and Festival Marketplace.
 Attendance in 2016 was 40% higher than 2015!
